Accelpoint.pl Website Privacy Policy

1. General Information

1. The operator of the website www.accelpoint.pl is the company Accelpoint sp z o. o. operating at the address accelpoint.pl.
2. The website collects information about Users and their behavior in the following ways:
 - having them voluntarily enter information via forms, questionnaires, surveys
 - saving cookies files in end devices,
 - collecting web server logs by the ZenBox hosting operator, operating at zenbox.pl.

2. Information in Forms, Questionnaires, Surveys

1. The website collects information provided voluntarily by the User.
2. The Website may also save information about parameters of the internet connection (timestamp, IP address).
3. Submitted data is not made available to third parties without the User's consent.
4. Submitted data is processed for purposes resulting from function of the form, survey, or questionnaire, i.e. acceleration and business and technology support for teams applying for the Acceleration Programme.

3. Information About Cookies.

1. The website uses cookies files.
2. Cookies are data, in particular text files, stored on the User's end device and are intended for use by the Website. Cookies usually contain the name of the website they originate from, their storage time on the end device and a unique number.
3. The Entity placing the cookies on the Website User's end device and obtaining access to them is the Website Administrator.
4. Cookies are used to create statistics that help to understand how Website Users use websites, allowing improving their structure and content;
5. The Website uses two basic types of cookies: "session" and "persistent" cookies. Session cookies are temporary files that are stored on the User's end device until he/she has logged out, leaving the Website or turning off the software (web browser). Persistent cookies are stored in the User's device for a time specified in cookie file parameters or until they are deleted by the User.
6. Website browsing software (Browsers) usually by default allows the storage of cookies on the end device of the User. Website Users can change the settings in this area. The Browser allows deleting cookies. It is also possible to automatically block cookies. Detailed information on this subject is available in the help files or documentation of the Browser.
7. Restrictions on the use of cookies may affect some of the functionalities available on the Website.
8. Website cookies deposited on the User's end device may also be used by partners cooperating with the Website Administrator. We recommend you read the privacy policies of these companies to learn about how cookies are used in statistics in the [Google Analytics Privacy Policy](#).

4. Server Logs

1. Information about some User activity is logged on servers. This data is used solely for website administration and to ensure the highest efficiency hosting services.
2. The browsed resources are identified by URL addresses. In addition, other registered data may include:
 - query arrival time,
 - time the response is sent,
 - name of the client station - identification performed by the HTTP protocol,
 - information on errors that occurred during the HTTP transaction,
 - URL address of the page previously visited by the user (referrer link) - in case the Website was accessed via a link,
 - information about the User's Browser
 - Information about the IP address.
3. The above data is not linked with specific person browsing the website.
4. The above data is used only for server administration

5. Providing Data

1. User data is only made available to third parties within legally permitted limits.
2. Data enabling the identification of a natural person is only made available with that person's consent.
3. The operator may be required to provide information collected by the Website to respective authorities based on legally binding requests to an extent resulting from the request.

6. Managing Cookies Files - How to Express and Withdraw Consent in Practice?

1. If a User does not want to receive cookies, he/she may change the Browser settings. We point out that disabling cookies necessary for authentication processes, security, maintaining user preferences may make it difficult to use online websites, and in extreme cases may prevent the use of online websites.
